

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3825

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the
2 line.

3 Delete lines 5 through 20 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 18.194, judgment remedies for a judgment of con-**
5 **viction entered in a municipal court or justice court for violating, prior to July 1, 2015, a city**
6 **or county ordinance or state statute prohibiting the possession of less than one ounce of**
7 **marijuana, that have not yet expired under the provisions of ORS 18.194, expire on the ef-**
8 **fective date of this 2025 Act.**

9 **“(2) If the judgment remedies for monetary obligations in a judgment of conviction have**
10 **expired under subsection (1) of this section, a person shall be considered to have completed,**
11 **fully complied with and performed the sentence of the court with respect to those monetary**
12 **obligations for purposes of ORS 137.225 or 475C.397 or any other statute authorizing the court**
13 **to set aside the judgment of conviction.**

14 **“SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**
15 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
