

# House Bill 3828

Sponsored by Representative CHOTZEN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells a state agency to study what rules might work to protect personal data. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to study the effects of regulating sensitive data. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to consumer protection no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to privacy protection for personal data.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall study the effects**  
5 **of regulating sensitive data. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
6 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees**  
7 **of the Legislative Assembly related to consumer protection no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
