House Bill 3842

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Gives moneys to school districts to fund services for migrant children. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Education for distribution to school districts to fund services to migrant children in a manner that is consistent with the Migrant Education Program. Declaring an emergency, effective on July 1, 2025.

4 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the 5

General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be distributed to school districts to fund 6

services provided to migrant children in a manner consistent with the Migrant Education 7

8 Program, as established by Title I, Part C of the federal Elementary and Secondary Educa-

tion Act of 1965, including expanding eligibility criteria and providing services for children 9

for up to six years. 10

SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 11 12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025. 13
