House Bill 3888

Sponsored by Representative SMITH G

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act requires LCDC to adopt rules for siting homes for builders of solar energy plants. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.3).

Requires the Land Conservation and Development Commission to, on or before June 30, 2026, adopt rules allowing temporary housing for the construction of solar power generation facilities. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to solar power generation facilities; and prescribing an effective date.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> On or before June 30, 2026, the Land Conservation and Development Commission shall adopt rules allowing on-site and off-site temporary workforce housing to be sited with solar photovoltaic power generation facilities, as appropriate for the construction of such facilities and consistent with rules allowing housing sited with wind power generation facilities, to the extent practicable.
 - SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
