

House Bill 3913

Sponsored by Representative MANNIX

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes the Department of Corrections pay counties for housing inmates in some instances. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Requires the Department of Corrections to reimburse counties for incarcerating a defendant if the defendant is sentenced to a felony and receives credit for time served in a local correctional facility.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to corrections.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) If a court imposes a felony sentence on an individual that includes credit**
5 **for time served in a local correctional facility, the Department of Corrections shall reim-**
6 **burse the county for the costs of incarcerating the individual in the local correctional facil-**
7 **ity.**

8 **(2) Reimbursement made to counties under subsection (1) of this section may not exceed**
9 **\$125 per day.**

10 **(3) The department shall adopt rules prescribing the manner in which counties may**
11 **submit a claim for reimbursement under this section.**
