## House Bill 3925

Sponsored by Representatives NGUYEN H, DOBSON; Representative NGUYEN D, Senator MEEK

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DAS to give a grant to Clackamas County to improve the Sunrise Corridor. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to issue a grant to Clackamas County for infrastructure improvements in the Sunrise Corridor. Allocates lottery revenues to the department for the grant.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Sunrise Corridor; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall issue a grant to

5 Clackamas County to be used for transportation infrastructure improvements in the Sunrise
6 Corridor.

SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Admin istrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Department of Administrative
Services, the amount of \$30,000,000 to be distributed by grant to Clackamas County pursuant
to section 1 of this 2025 Act.
SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025
