SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

[Allows a health care facility to apply for an expedited reissuance of a license if the health care facility was previously licensed within the last 24 months, closed voluntarily or due to financial hardship and will resume operations with no significant changes.]

Allows a person or government unit to use an expedited licensure process to operate a health care facility, if the license is to operate a health care facility in the same physical location and of the same type as a health care facility that previously operated at the location and the previously operated health care facility closed within the last 24 months vol-untarily or due to financial hardship.

Allows an applicant to be issued a provisional license to operate the health care facility while the applicant's application is being processed and reviewed. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to an expedited licensure process for health care facilities; and prescribing an effective 3 date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 441.015 to 6 441.119.

SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Health Authority, for health care facilities, except long term 7 care facilities as defined in ORS 442.015, and the Department of Human Services, for long 8 9 term care facilities, shall provide for an expedited licensure process.

10 (2) A person or government unit shall be eligible to use the expedited licensure process to apply for a license to operate a health care facility, if the license is to operate a health 11 12care facility in the same physical location with no significant structural or functional 13 changes and of the same type as a health care facility that previously operated at the location and the previously operated health care facility closed within the last 24 months and 14 was closed voluntarily or due to financial hardship. 15

16 (3) Under the expedited licensure process:

(a) An eligible applicant shall be issued a license to operate a health care facility if: 17

(A) The applicant currently operates a health care facility located in this state that is 18 of the same type as the health care facility for which the applicant is applying for a license 19

20to operate;

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1 (B) The applicant is in good standing under the laws and regulations of this state;

2 (C) There are no current or outstanding compliance issues at any health care facility 3 that the applicant operates located in this state;

4 (D) Each licensed health care provider that works at a health care facility that the ap-5 plicant operates located in this state holds a license that is in good standing; and

6 (E) The health care facility for which the applicant is applying for a license to operate 7 is in compliance with all rules and regulations of this state that apply to the health care fa-8 cility.

9 (b) A license shall be issued within 45 days after the date an application is filed if the
10 health care facility meets the criteria listed under paragraph (a) of this subsection, unless
11 a waiver is granted under paragraph (c) of this subsection.

12 (c) Waivers for construction and inspection requirements shall be granted as appropriate.

(4)(a) An applicant shall be issued a provisional license to operate the health care facility while the applicant's application is being processed and reviewed under subsection (3) of this section, if the applicant submits an attestation that the applicant and health care facility meet all health and safety rules and regulations that apply to the health care facility.

(b) Prior to issuing a provisional license, the authority or department shall conduct an
 in-person site inspection of the health care facility under ORS 441.025 (1).

(c) The authority or department may prescribe by rule a fee to be charged for a provi sional license.

(5) A license may not be issued under this section for a health care facility if a certificate
 of need is required under ORS 442.315 and has not been obtained.

23 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 24 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.

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
