## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3942

On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, delete lines 6 through 23 and delete page 2 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section: 3 "(a) 'Applicant' includes a person's or governmental unit's parent corporation or any entity affiliated with the person, governmental unit or parent corporation through owner-4 ship, governance, control or membership.  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 "(b) 'Health care facility' does not include a: 7 "(A) Long term care facility. "(B) Residential facility that primarily serves persons under 21 years of age. 8 9 "(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall provide for an expedited licensure process under 10 ORS 441.015 to 441.119 for health care facilities. 11 "(3)(a) Under the expedited licensure process, the authority shall issue an applicant a li-12cense to operate a health care facility if: 13"(A) The license is to operate a health care facility in the same physical location with 14 no significant structural or functional changes and of the same type as a health care facility 15that previously operated at the location and the previously operated health care facility 16 closed within the last 60 months and was closed voluntarily or due to financial hardship; 17 "(B) The applicant currently operates a health care facility that is located in this state 18 and that is of the same type as the health care facility for which the applicant is applying 19 for a license to operate; 20 "(C) The applicant is in good standing under the laws and regulations of this state; 21"(D) There are no current or outstanding compliance issues at any health care facility 22that the applicant operates located in this state; 23 "(E) Each licensed health care provider who works at a health care facility that the ap-24plicant operates located in this state holds a license that is in good standing; and 25"(F) The health care facility for which the applicant is applying for a license to operate is in compliance with all rules and regulations of this state that apply to the health care fa-2627cility. 28(b) The authority shall issue a license to operate a health care facility within 45 days 29after the date on which an applicant files an application if the applicant and health care facility meet the requirements listed under paragraph (a) of this subsection or receive a waiver 30 31for a requirement under paragraph (c) of this subsection. 32"(c) The authority shall grant, as appropriate, waivers for construction and inspection 33 requirements. 34"(4)(a) The authority shall issue an applicant a provisional license to operate the health 35care facility while the applicant's application is being processed and reviewed under sub1 section (3) of this section, if:

2 "(A) The applicant submits an attestation that the applicant and health care facility meet 3 all health and safety rules and regulations that apply to the health care facility; and

4 "(B) Upon conducting a site inspection under paragraph (b) of this subsection, the au-5 thority finds that the operation of the health care facility does not place patient health or 6 safety in immediate jeopardy.

"(b) Prior to issuing a provisional license, the authority shall conduct an in-person site
inspection of the health care facility under ORS 441.025.

"(c) The authority may prescribe by rule a fee to be charged for a provisional license.

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"(5) A person or governmental unit is ineligible to use the expedited licensure process if:

"(a) The person or governmental unit voluntarily surrendered a license to operate a
 health care facility during the course of a licensing or abuse investigation;

13 "(b) The person or governmental unit voluntarily surrendered the license as part of a 14 negotiated agreement, settlement or resolution to avoid a license revocation; and

"(c) The authority suspended or imposed conditions on the license within the 12 months
 immediately preceding the date on which the person or governmental unit surrendered the
 license.

"(6) A license may not be issued under this section for a health care facility if a certif icate of need is required under ORS 442.315 and has not been obtained.".

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
