## House Bill 3967

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court may take some money and benefits from judges. (Flesch Readability Score: 75.7).

Provides that the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court may impound funds and eliminate benefits available to a judge that are not compensation to which a judge is entitled under the Oregon Constitution.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to judges.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In the exercise of administrative authority and supervision over the courts

5 of this state, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court has the authority to take actions and

6 establish rules that promote judicial accountability and fair and accessible justice services,

7 consistent with the mission of the state courts, including the ability to impound funds and

8 eliminate benefits available to a judge that are not compensation to which a judge is entitled

9 under Article VII (Amended), section 8, of the Oregon Constitution.
