## A-Engrossed House Bill 5003

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Commission for the Blind for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the commission.

Limits biennial expenditures by the commission from federal funds.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Commission for the Blind; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Commission for the Blind, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$9,497,634 for operations of the commission.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,148,422 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission for the Blind.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$22,135,700 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Commission for the Blind.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
