SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures by the commission from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the commission.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Limits biennial expenditures by the commission from federal funds.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the
6	biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$19,514,353.
7	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$628,510
8	is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of
9	expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established under
10	ORS 406.140 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for veterans' specialty courts.
11	SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
12	\$151,247,749 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for
13	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
14	but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Criminal
15	Justice Commission.
16	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
17	\$15,098,131 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for
18	payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice
19	Commission.
20	SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
21	ated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025,
22	out of the General Fund, the amount of \$54,861,333, for deposit into the Oregon Public Safety
23	Fund established by section 4, chapter, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 3069).

19 <u>SECTION 10.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-20 priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, 21 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000, for deposit into the Oregon Jail-Based 22 Medications for Opioid Use Disorder Fund established by section 87, chapter 70, Oregon Laws 23 2024.

24 <u>SECTION 11.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 26 July 1, 2025.
