

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5014

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium be-
3 ginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following pur-
4 poses:

14 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
15 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment
16 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
17 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice,
18 for the following purposes:

- 20 General and Administration \$ 63,106,199
- 21 (2) Appellate Division \$ 35,101,104
- 22 (3) Civil Enforcement Division \$ 79,814,934
- 23 (4) Child Advocacy Division..... \$ 96,062,875
- 24 (5) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 9,185,540
- 25 (6) Crime Victim and Survivor
- 26 Services Division..... \$ 48,288,642
- 27 (7) General Counsel Division..... \$101,946,559
- 28 (8) Trial Division \$ 79,080,639
- 29 (9) Division of Child Support..... \$ 26,241,654
- 30 (10) Debt Service and Related
- 31 Costs.....\$ 7,380,272

32 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
33 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment
34 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice for the
35 following purposes:

- 1 **(1) Civil Enforcement Division..... \$ 8,701,174**
- 2 **(2) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 1,514,738**
- 3 **(3) Crime Victim and Survivor**
- 4 **Services Division..... \$ 48,446,057**
- 5 **(4) Division of Child Support..... \$163,900,073**

6 **SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
7 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
8 **July 1, 2025."**
