House Bill 5016

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates agency budgets. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel Committee, Legislative Fiscal Officer, Legislative Revenue Officer, Commission on Indian Services and Legislative Policy and Research Committee for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by certain legislative branch agencies.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 10 \$1,883,547 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for 11 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 12 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or receive by the Legislative Admin-13 istration Committee.
