

House Bill 5018

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the State Board of Licensed Social Workers.
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the board.
Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Board of Licensed Social Workers; and declar-
3 ing an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Board of Licensed Social Workers, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$625,000 for oper-**
7 **ations of the board.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
9 **\$3,118,162 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**
10 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
11 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Board of**
12 **Licensed Social Workers.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
15 **July 1, 2025.**
