For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Oregon Liquor 21and Cannabis Commission for liquor purchases are not limited. "SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 22peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 2324July 1, 2025.". 25
