

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5024

14 **priated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July**
15 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$77,160,206, for infrastructure, for grants**
16 **approved in section 9, chapter 109, Oregon Laws 2024.**

17 “**SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appro-**
18 **priated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July**
19 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for infrastructure, for grants ap-**
20 **proved in section 5, chapter 103, Oregon Laws 2024:**

21 (1) **City of Toledo..... \$ 640,000**
22 (2) **City of McMinnville..... \$ 2,000,000**

23 “**SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appro-**
24 **priated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July**
25 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for infrastructure, for grants ap-**
26 **proved in section 2, chapter 475, Oregon Laws 2023:**

27 (1) **Warm Springs water and**
28 **wastewater systems..... \$ 2,707,565**
29 (2) **St. Helens waterfront**
30 **redevelopment..... \$ 977,122**
31 (3) **Port of Coos Bay navigation**
32 **channel..... \$ 5,000,000**

33 “**SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
34 **priated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July**
35 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, for infrastructure, for grants ap-**

proved in section 28, chapter 606, Oregon Laws 2023.

“SECTION 7. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for arts, for grants approved in section 496, chapter 114, Oregon Laws 2024:

- (1) Southern Oregon Historical Society \$ 480,234
- (2) Friends of the Oregon Caves and Chateau \$ 455,690
- (3) Salem Parks Foundation..... \$ 150,000
- (4) Clatsop County Historical Society \$ 1,000,000
- (5) Black United Fund of Oregon... \$ 900,000
- (6) Very Little Theatre..... \$ 36,339
- (7) Portland Institute for Contemporary Art..... \$ 135,625

“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

- (1) Operations..... \$ 8,475,102
- (2) Business, innovation and trade..... \$ 90,372,061
- (3) Infrastructure..... \$322,563,944
- (4) Arts..... \$ 16,416,419

“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$197,247,462 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Business Development Department, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 196, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021.

“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from the Broadband Fund established by ORS 285A.167, for the following purposes:

- (1) Operations..... \$ 546,916
- (2) Infrastructure..... \$108,002,343

“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

- (1) Operations..... \$ 19,816,525

- 1 (2) Business, innovation
2 and trade..... \$ 78,857,998
3 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 21,039,054
4 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,541,600
5 (5) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 66,293,285

6 “**SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following
7 amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for
8 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business De-
9 velopment Department, for the following purposes:

- 10 (1) Operations..... \$ 1,461,212
11 (2) Business, innovation
12 and trade..... \$ 59,333,558
13 (3) Infrastructure..... \$219,985,409
14 (4) Arts..... \$ 2,301,442

15 “**SECTION 13.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Oregon
16 Business Development Department are not limited for:

17 “(1) Loans from the following funds:

18 “(a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-
19 opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small
20 Business Expansion Loan Fund (ORS 285B.133).

21 “(b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine
22 Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708),
23 Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213), Brownfields Redevelopment Fund
24 (ORS 285A.188) and Oregon Brownfield Properties Revitalization Fund (ORS 285A.198).

25 “(2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation
26 bonds.

27 “**SECTION 14.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
29 July 1, 2025.”.
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
