- "SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 45

HA to HB 5025 Page 2 \$2,907,137,415 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Public Employees' Benefit Board from the Public Employees' Revolving Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

"SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,244,863,726 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board from the Oregon Educators Revolving Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

"SECTION 9. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, to be allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for Oregon State Hospital operational challenges.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2026, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 10. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".

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
