 - "SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Police from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the Department of State Police, for deferred maintenance, capital project costs and safety improvements.
 - "SECTION 6. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".
