5 (1) **Debt service** ...... \$ 8,789,990

(2) Facilities repairs ...... \$ 1,133,830

13 (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund ... \$ 322,411

<sup>14</sup> "<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of <sup>15</sup> \$7,967,812 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for <sup>16</sup> payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Public <sup>17</sup> Safety Standards and Training.

"SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
July 1, 2025.".
