2 After line 24, insert:

3 “Whereas Lyllye Reynolds-Parker became involved in activism as a teenager, serving as vice
4 president of the Eugene chapter of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee and as a member
5 of the Congress of Racial Equality, where she trained in nonviolent civil disobedience; and”.

6 On page 2, line 3, after “years,” insert “from 1995 to 2012,”.

7 After line 9, insert:

8 “Whereas for so many students, the mentorship Lyllye Reynolds-Parker provided lasted well
9 beyond their time at UO; and”.

10 After line 20, insert:

11 “Whereas in 2025, the UO Senate established the Lyllye Reynolds-Parker Award, recognizing
12 professional staff and graduate employees who exemplified exceptional mentorship by creating a
13 supportive, inclusive environment and encouraging students to reach their full potential; and”.
