## **House Concurrent Resolution 37**

## SUMMARY

5	Whereas in the summer of 1966, after graduating from Mankato State College, Andy moved to
6	Oregon; and
7	Whereas following a job at Samaritan Albany General Hospital in Albany, Oregon, Andy joined
8	the Secretary of State Audits Division in Salem as a Certified Public Accountant; and
9	Whereas Andy was a firm believer in grassroots democracy, and served 52 years as a Marion
10	County Democratic Precinct Committeeperson; and
11	Whereas Andy served as chair of the Young Democrats of Oregon from 1977 to 1978; and
12	Whereas following his time with the Young Democrats, Andy chaired the Marion County Dem-
13	ocratic Central Committee from 1978 to 1985; and
14	Whereas Andy was also a member of both the State Central Committee and the Congressional
15	Central Committee from 1978 to 1985; and
16	Whereas Andy also served as chair for the Salem-Keizer Public Schools Community Relations
17	Committee, the Marion County DemoForum program, and the Neighborhood Leader Program in
18	Marion County, which he set up; and
19	Whereas Andy also created the Neighbor-to-Neighbor Program in the City of Salem, and he ran
20	it for five years; and
21	Whereas Andy married his wife, LeAnn, in 1979, and they raised their two children, Brandon
22	and Holly, in Salem; and
23	Whereas Andy was an avid hiker and camper who spent countless days making memories with
24	his family on the Metolius River and the Oregon coast; and
25	Whereas Andy was a committed career public educator, a loyal and passionate University of
26	Oregon Ducks fan, and a loving and beloved husband, father and grandfather; and
27	Whereas Andy passed away at Salem Health on September 21, 2024; and
28	Whereas Andy is survived by his wife, LeAnn, his son Brandon and daughter Holly, his
29	daughter-in-law Jill, his grandsons Caleb, Chase and Lowell, his granddaughter Lucy, his siblings
