

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 39

1       On page 2 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “now, therefore,” and insert “and”.

2       After line 3, insert:

3       “Whereas Sergeant Dwight Hayes of Oregon City, a United States Army field illumination  
4 crewman, died from injuries sustained during an accident in Phuoc Tuy Province, South Vietnam,  
5 on February 6, 1970; and

6       “Whereas Specialist Four Robert Dean Neasham of Canby, a United States Army heavy vehicle  
7 driver, died from a self-inflicted wound in Binh Dinh Province, South Vietnam, on October 13, 1968;  
8 and

9       “Whereas Staff Sergeant Warren Emery Newton of Canby, a helicopter repairman in the United  
10 States Army, died when his helicopter was shot down and exploded in Quang Tin Province, South  
11 Vietnam, on January 9, 1968, and he was declared MIA until his remains were recovered and iden-  
12 tified in 2015; and

13       “Whereas Private First Class Curtis Neil Evans of Gladstone, a United States Army  
14 infantryman, died from small arms fire in Kon Tum Province, South Vietnam, on September 2, 1968;  
15 and

16       “Whereas Lance Corporal Walter David Freeman of Gladstone, a United States Marine Corps  
17 rifleman, died from small arms fire in Quang Nam Province, South Vietnam, on December 2, 1968;  
18 and

19       “Whereas Airman Brian Lee Bushnell of Tualatin, a structural mechanic in the United States  
20 Navy, died in a crash at sea in the Gulf of Tonkin, North Vietnam, on April 9, 1970; and

21       “Whereas Private First Class Robert Wayne Clarke of West Linn, a United States Marine Corps  
22 rifleman, died of wounds inflicted by an explosive device in Quang Tri Province, South Vietnam, on  
23 August 26, 1968; and

24       “Whereas Warrant Officer Allen Dean Perkins of West Linn, a helicopter pilot in the United  
25 States Army, died in a helicopter crash in Bien Hoa, Dong Nai Province, South Vietnam, on No-  
26 vember 24, 1969; and

27       “Whereas Lance Corporal Steven Adrian Smith of West Linn, a United States Marine Corps  
28 rifleman, died of wounds inflicted by artillery, rocket or mortar fire in Quang Tri Province, South  
29 Vietnam, on October 26, 1967; and

30       “Whereas Private First Class Dale William Tolbert of West Linn, a United States Army  
31 infantryman, died from multiple fragmentation wounds inflicted in Binh Duong Province, South  
32 Vietnam, on May 19, 1967; now, therefore,”.

33       Delete lines 5 through 9 and insert:
