# **House Concurrent Resolution 42**

# SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The measure states that it is the intent of the House and the Senate to cut taxes in HB 2025 (2025) when other laws are passed. (Flesch Readability Test: 60.0).

Expresses the intent of the Legislative Assembly to reduce or phase out taxes enacted in chapter \_\_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 2025), when alternative funding sources are enacted and operative.

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### **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

### 2 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

(1) If the conditions in subsection (2) of this resolution are satisfied, it is the intent of the Leg-

4 islative Assembly to reduce or phase out:

(a) The increases to the privilege tax and the privilege use tax made by the amendments to ORS
320.405 and 320.410 in chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 2025);

7 (b) The increase to the tax on wages for transit made by the amendments to ORS 320.550 in

8 chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 2025); and

9 (c) The transfer tax and the transfer use tax imposed under sections 83 and 84, chapter
10 \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 2025).

11 (2) It is the intent of the Legislative Assembly to enact the changes described in subsection (1)

of this resolution when new funding sources, including but not limited to a cap-and-invest program, are enacted and operative.

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
