Senate Bill 1010

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells BOLI to study and report on certain protected activities. The Act tells

BOLI to submit a report on the findings by a certain date. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues related to safeguarding protected labor relations activities. Directs the bureau to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to protected labor relations activities.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study issues related to safeguarding protected labor relations activities. The bureau shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
