## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act gives moneys to the Liberty House for CAC services. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice out of the General Fund for distribution to the Liberty House to provide children's advocacy center services.

5 ginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 for distribution to the

6 Liberty House to provide children's advocacy center services, including child abuse medical

- 7 assessments, forensic interviewing, mental health services and child abuse prevention edu-
