SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs DHS to have a supply of appropriate carriers to use when moving a foster child's things. The Act prohibits DHS from using trash bags to carry the personal items of a foster child. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.0).

Directs the Department of Human Services to maintain an inventory of appropriate carriers for the transportation of a foster child's personal belongings. Prohibits the department [of Human Services] from using trash bags to transport the personal belongings of a foster child.

8	or transitioning or exiting from foster care.
9	(2) The department may not use trash bags to transport a foster child's personal effects.

16	transportation of the personal effects of foster children in the manner provided by ORS 192.245,

18	sembly related to human services no later than September 15 of each year. The report must

20	(1) The department's supply of appropriate carriers for the transportation of a foster

24	(3) If in the preceding reporting period trash bags were used to transport a foster child's
