Senate Bill 1016

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act prohibits DHS from using trash bags to carry the personal items of a foster child. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

Prohibits the Department of Human Services from using trash bags to transport the personal belongings of a foster child.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to transportation of the personal belongings of foster children; amending section 1, chapter
 210, Oregon Laws 2023.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 1, chapter 210, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to read:

6 Sec. 1. (1)(a) The Department of Human Services shall procure, distribute and maintain an in-7 ventory of appropriate luggage carriers for child welfare case workers to use when transporting the 8 personal effects of a foster child, including when the foster child is entering into or transitioning 9 or exiting from foster care.

(b) The department may not use trash bags to transport a foster child's personal effects.
(2) The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may in-

clude recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
to human services no later than September 15 of each year. The report must describe:

(a) The department's supply of appropriate luggage carriers for the transportation of a
 foster child's personal effects;

(b) The department's luggage carrier supply inventory management practices; and

(c) If in the preceding reporting period trash bags were used to transport a foster child's personal effects, the number of instances in the preceding reporting period that trash bags were used to transport a foster child's personal effects[,] and the reasons for using the trash bags[, the department's supply of appropriate luggage carriers and its supply inventory management practices].
