

Senate Bill 1039

Sponsored by Senator REYNOLDS, Representatives OWENS, BOWMAN; Senators PATTERSON, WEBER, Representatives NELSON, PHAM H

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an entity to work toward improving health outcomes for mothers and children. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Creates the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative in the Oregon Health and Science University. Describes the collaborative's responsibilities.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative in the Oregon Health**
5 **and Science University.**

6 **(2) The responsibilities of the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative shall include:**

7 **(a) Coordinating statewide efforts for quality improvement in maternal and childhood**
8 **health; and**

9 **(b) Developing policy recommendations to further maternal and childhood health.**

10 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
11 **ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
12 **General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for distribution to the Oregon Health and Science**
13 **University for carrying out section 1 of this 2025 Act.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**
15 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
