Senate Bill 1039

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an entity to work toward improving health outcomes for mothers and children. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Creates the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative in the Oregon Health and Science University. Describes the collaborative's responsibilities.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative; and prescribing an effective date.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative in the Oregon Health and Science University.
 - (2) The responsibilities of the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative shall include:
 - (a) Coordinating statewide efforts for quality improvement in maternal and childhood health; and
 - (b) Developing policy recommendations to further maternal and childhood health.
 - SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for distribution to the Oregon Health and Science University for carrying out section 1 of this 2025 Act.
 - SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
