SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1051

In line 2 of the printed bill, before the period insert "; and declaring an emergency". 1 Delete lines 4 through 28 and insert: "SECTION 1. ORS 526.031 is amended to read: 3 "526.031. [(1) The State Board of Forestry shall appoint a State Forester, who must be a practical forester familiar with western conditions and experienced in organization for the prevention of forest 5 fires. The forester shall be the chief executive officer of the State Forestry Department. The forester shall hold office at the pleasure of the board, and shall act as its secretary.] "(1) The Governor shall appoint a State Forester subject to Senate confirmation under 8 9 ORS 171.562 and 171.565. The forester shall be the chief executive officer of the State 10 Forestry Department and shall act as the secretary of the State Board of Forestry. The 11 forester shall serve a term of four years at the pleasure of the Governor and shall be eligible 12 for reappointment. 13 "(2)(a) With the approval of the board and subject to applicable provisions of the State Person-14 nel Relations Law, the State Forester may appoint a Deputy State Forester, assistant state foresters 15 and other employees of the department. 16 "(b) The State Forester must have organizational management experience and either of 17 the following: 18 "(A) Executive experience and expertise overseeing forest and wildfire management on 19 western forestlands; or 20 "(B) Operational experience and expertise overseeing forest and wildfire management on 21 western forestlands. 22 "(c) During the State Forester's absence or disability, all authority shall be exercised by the 23 Deputy State Forester [or by the assistant whom the State Forester or the board, by written order filed 24 with the Secretary of State, has designated as Acting State Forester]. 25 "[(3) The board shall fix the compensation of the State Forester. In addition to their salaries, the 26 forester, the deputy and assistants shall be reimbursed, subject to the limitations otherwise provided 27 by law, for their actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of their 28 duties.] 29 "(3)(a) The State Forester shall receive a salary as provided by law or, if not so provided, as prescribed by the Governor. 30 31 "(b) In addition to salary, but subject to any applicable law regulating travel and other expenses of state officers and employees, the State Forester, the Deputy State Forester and 32 assistant state foresters shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and other ex-33 34 penses incurred by the State Forester, the Deputy State Forester and assistant state

foresters in the performance of official duties.

"SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.".
