## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 1062

Ordered by the Senate April 16 Including Senate Amendments dated April 16

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would let each of the three cities of Bandon, North Bend and Reedsport set fees for water and wastewater services by a majority vote. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.0).

[Digest: The Act would require a study of local authority over regulated utility rates and works. The Act would require a report of the study to be turned in next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).]

[Requires the Secretary of State to study local authority over regulated utility rates and infrastructure maintenance. Directs the secretary to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to rules no later than September 15, 2026.]

Provides that each of the cities of Bandon, North Bend and Reedsport may set charges for water and wastewater services provided by the city by a majority vote of its governing body.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to local authority over regulated utilities.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) This section applies to the City of Bandon, the City of North Bend and

5 the City of Reedsport.

6 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of the city's charter or code to the contrary, fees,

7 rates or any other charges imposed for municipal water and wastewater services provided

8 by the city may be set by a majority vote of the governing body of the city.
