Senate Bill 1071

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act requires LCDC to approve the UGB amendments by the City of Coos Bay. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.1).

Directs the Land Conservation and Development Commission to approve amendments to the urban growth boundary submitted by the City of Coos Bay.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. On or before January 1, 2026, and notwithstanding ORS 197.626 or any pro
5	vision of ORS chapter 197A or rule of the Land Conservation and Development Commission
6	the commission shall issue an order:
7	(1) Approving the amendments to the urban growth boundary by the City of Coos Bay
8	that were adopted by an ordinance of the city dated and were submitted to the com
9	mission for review on; and
10	(2) Declaring the approved urban growth boundary to be the acknowledged urban growth
11	boundary for the city.
12	SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025
13	regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
