Senate Bill 1080

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act prohibits local or agency bans of energy use. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2). Prevents local governments or state agencies from prohibiting natural gas use or other energy options in or availability for new or existing residential or commercial buildings.

2 Relating to regulation of energy use in buildings.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.

5 SECTION 2. A local government may not adopt or enforce any land use regulation or

6 other ordinance, and a state agency may not adopt any rule other than regulations adopted

pursuant to the state building code for the purposes provided in ORS 455.020, that has the
effect of:

9 (1) Prohibiting the installation or use of natural gas in existing or new residential or 10 commercial buildings;

11 (2) Prohibiting the installation of natural gas infrastructure serving lands zoned to allow

12 for residential or commercial uses; or

(3) Otherwise limiting the access, installation or use of any energy options in existing or
new residential or commercial buildings.
