SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that a county clerk must cancel a voter's registration as required by federal law. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.1). Requires a county clerk to cancel a voter registration in accordance with the requirements of

the federal National Voter Registration Act of 1993.

4 SECTION 1. ORS 247.555 is amended to read:

5 247.555. (1) A county clerk [may] shall, in accordance with the requirements of the admin-

istration of voter registration provisions of the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (P.L. 6

7 103-31), cancel the registration of an elector:

- 8 (a) At the request of the elector;
- 9 (b) Upon the death of the elector;

(c) If the county clerk receives written evidence that the elector has registered to vote in an-10 11

other state; or

12 (d) If the elector has not responded to a notice described in ORS 247.563 and has not voted or updated a registration during the period beginning on the date the notice is sent and ending on the 13 day after the date of the second regular general election that occurs after the date the notice was 14

15sent.

(2) If the registration of an elector is canceled, the elector, in order to vote in an election, must 16

register as provided in this chapter. 17

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
