

Senate Bill 1115

Sponsored by Senator REYNOLDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes DAS do a study on social media and submit a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study social media. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to information management not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

Relating to social media.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall study social media. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to information management no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
