Senate Bill 1117

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the Division of Audits to do a performance audit of ODOT. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Directs the Division of Audits to conduct a performance audit of the Department of Transportation.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a performance audit of the Department of Transportation; and prescribing an effective 3 date.

- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "performance audit" has the meaning given that 6 term in ORS 297.070.
- 7 (2) The Division of Audits shall conduct a performance audit of the Department of

8 Transportation relating to the use of moneys in the State Highway Fund.

- 9 (3) The division shall complete the performance audit on or before January 1, 2027.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025
 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
