

# Senate Bill 1117

Sponsored by Senator MEEK, Representatives HARTMAN, PHAM H; Representatives DOBSON, NGUYEN D

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the Division of Audits to do a performance audit of ODOT. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Directs the Division of Audits to conduct a performance audit of the Department of Transportation.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a performance audit of the Department of Transportation; and prescribing an effective  
3 date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "performance audit" has the meaning given that**  
6 **term in ORS 297.070.**

7 **(2) The Division of Audits shall conduct a performance audit of the Department of**  
8 **Transportation relating to the use of moneys in the State Highway Fund.**

9 **(3) The division shall complete the performance audit on or before January 1, 2027.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**  
11 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
