Senate Bill 1127

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Allows ODE to award grants for activities at Title I schools during recess, lunch or after school. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.1).

Authorizes the Department of Education to expend moneys from the Statewide Education Initiatives Account for the purpose of awarding grants to develop and provide educational activities during recess, lunch or after school for Title I elementary schools.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> For the 2025-2027 biennium and in addition to and not in lieu of any appro-6 priation, the Department of Education shall expend the amount of \$500,000 from the State-

7 wide Education Initiatives Account for the purpose of awarding to school districts grants to

8 develop and provide educational activities during recess, lunch or after school at schools of

9 the school districts that are considered high poverty under Title I of the federal Elementary

and Secondary Act of 1965 and that serve students in any grade from kindergarten through

11 grade six.

12 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
July 1, 2025.
