SUMMARY

Digest: This Act requires LCDC to amend its rules relating to urban reserves. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.7).

Requires the Land Conservation and Development Commission to amend its rules relating to urban reserves.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 197A.230 to
5	197A.250.
6	SECTION 2. On or before January 1, 2026, the Land Conservation and Developmen
7	Commission shall amend its rules related to the prioritization of lands being added to an
8	urban reserve in order to allow local governments to:
9	(1) Give a lower priority to the inclusion of lands within an exception area approved un
10	der ORS 197.732 or nonresource lands containing planned developments or subdivisions com
11	pared to other nonresource lands or lands within an exception area.
12	(2) Give a lower priority to the inclusion of otherwise higher priority lands where pro
13	viding urban services, as defined in ORS 195.065, is not reasonable or cost effective due to
14	topographical or other physical constraints.
15	SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
17	on its passage.
