## Senate Bill 1155

Sponsored by Senator REYNOLDS, Representative BOWMAN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHCS to start a pilot program to help pregnant people and their families get stable housing. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.3).

Directs the Housing and Community Services Department to establish a pilot program to assist pregnant persons and their immediate family members in attaining stable housing. Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

 $\mathbf{2}$ Relating to affordable housing.

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Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

4 SECTION 1. (1) The Housing and Community Services Department shall establish a pilot 5 program to assist pregnant persons and their immediate family members who are members 6 of a low income household to attain stable housing that begins as early as the person con-7 ceives and continues at least until the child is at least two years of age. The housing must 8 be safe, affordable, accessible, sized to meet the needs of the family and located in proximity 9 to the places of employment and education of all members of the family and to the health care, child care and commercial services, and other community assets, beneficial to the 10 well-being of all members of the family. The housing must be subject to an affordable housing 11 12 covenant as described in ORS 456.270 to 456.295 that maintains the housing as affordable to low income households for a period of at least 10 years. 13

(2) In order to carry out the pilot program established under this section, the depart-14 15ment:

(a) Shall allow an owner of a rental housing project development financed by the de-16 partment to set aside housing units for participants in the pilot program; and 17

(b) May accept, from any organization or state or local government agency that offers 18 19 rental assistance, gifts, grants or other contributions of any portion of that rental assist-20ance.

(3) The department shall modify any existing scoring criteria for rental housing project 2122development applicants in order to give priority to applicants that commit to setting aside 23housing units for participants in the pilot program established under this section.

24(4) The department may adopt rules to carry out this section including rules to determine 25pilot program participant eligibility.

26 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.

27SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 281, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_, for the pilot program established 29
