Senate Bill 1165

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the OPDC to increase the hourly rate paid to investigators. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Public Defense Commission to increase the hourly rate for investigators.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Oregon Public Defense Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out

6 of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,330,220, for the purpose of increasing the hourly rate

7 paid to defense investigators.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
10 July 1, 2025.
