Senate Bill 1173

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that some product liability claims may not be filed against a health care facility. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.1).

Provides that a health care facility is not a manufacturer, distributor, seller or lessor of a product for purposes of a product liability civil action if the health care facility was not involved in the design or manufacture of the product.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

(1) A physician licensed pursuant to ORS chapter 677 is not a manufacturer, distributor, 6 seller or lessor of a product for the purposes of ORS 30.900 to 30.920 if: 7 (a) [The product is provided by the physician] The physician provides the product to a patient 8 as part of a medical procedure; and 9 10 (b) The physician was not involved in the design or manufacture of the product. (2) A health care facility licensed under ORS chapter 441 is not a manufacturer, distrib-11 utor, seller or lessor of a product for the purposes of ORS 30.900 to 30.920 if: 12 (a) The health care facility provides the product to a patient as part of health care ser-13vices; and 14 (b) The health care facility was not involved in the design or manufacture of the product. 15SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 30.902 by section 1 of this 2025 Act apply to actions 16 commenced on or after the effective date of this 2025 Act. 17 SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 18 19 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 20
