

Senate Bill 1205

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act extends the sunset for the tax subtraction for awards from wildfire lawsuits. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Extends the sunset for the personal income tax subtraction for amounts received in resolution of a civil action arising from wildfire.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to tax subtractions for amounts received in wildfire litigation; amending section 4, chapter 50, Oregon Laws 2024.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 4, chapter 50, Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

Sec. 4. (1) Section 2 [*of this 2024 Act*], **chapter 50, Oregon Laws 2024**, applies to declarations and executive orders issued on or after January 1, 2018, and before January 1, [2026] **2028**, and, notwithstanding ORS 315.037, to amounts received in all tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

(2) Section 3 [*of this 2024 Act*], **chapter 50, Oregon Laws 2024**, applies to:

(a) Declarations and executive orders issued on or after January 1, 2018, and before January 1, 2026; and

(b) Notwithstanding ORS 315.037, losses incurred and legal fees paid or incurred in all tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
