

Senate Bill 1207

Sponsored by Senator FREDERICK, Representative NELSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would give funds to a business group so that it may buy property to create a Black community cultural hub. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.2).

Appropriates moneys for distribution to Soul District Business Association for the acquisition and redevelopment of property as the AfroEats Community Cultural Hub in Portland.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to an appropriation for a community cultural hub.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,750,000 to be distributed to Soul District Business Association for the purpose of acquiring and re-developing property as the AfroEats Community Cultural Hub in Portland.
