

# Senate Bill 1209

Sponsored by Senator BROADMAN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that a person may not file a special motion to strike a claim brought by a public body. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.7).

Provides that a person may not file a special motion to strike a claim brought by a public body.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to special motions to strike; amending ORS 31.155.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 31.155 is amended to read:

31.155. (1) ORS 31.150 and 31.152 do not apply to an action brought by **a public body as defined in ORS 174.109 or by** the Attorney General, a district attorney, a county counsel or a city attorney acting in an official capacity.

(2) ORS 31.150 and 31.152 create a procedure for seeking dismissal of claims described in ORS 31.150 (2) and do not affect the substantive law governing those claims.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
