SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says that a person may not file a special motion to strike a claim brought by a public body. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.7).

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 31.155 is amended to read:

5 31.155. (1) ORS 31.150 and 31.152 do not apply to an action brought by a public body as defined

6 in ORS 174.109 or by the Attorney General, a district attorney, a county counsel or a city attorney

- 7 acting in an official capacity.
- 8 (2) ORS 31.150 and 31.152 create a procedure for seeking dismissal of claims described in ORS
- 9 31.150 (2) and do not affect the substantive law governing those claims.
