Senate Bill 1210

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells ODOT to get rid of some debts. (Flesch Readability Score: 100.0). Requires the Department of Transportation to forgive certain indebtedness. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
