Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following 15amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for 16 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 17 tobacco tax receipts, marijuana tax receipts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and 18 Medicare receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, 19 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for the following programs, to review 20 and modify forms and the electronic vital records system regarding the establishment of 21parentage:

<u>"SECTION 156.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
expenditures established by section 2 (4), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill
5014), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery
funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice, for the Child
Advocacy Division, is increased by \$183,402, for parentage law cases and training.".
