SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs the CJC to study assaults in the workplace. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3).

Requires the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study workplace assault convictions and sentences. Directs the commission to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to assaults in the workplace.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study convictions for assaults that occur in the workplace and the types of sentences received. The commission shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
