SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the State Court Administrator to look at civil procedure and make a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Requires the State Court Administrator to study civil procedure and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The State Court Administrator shall study civil procedure. The State Court Administrator shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include
- 6 recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-
- 7 lated to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
